Club Rules (revised 02-2015)

In this document, "The club", "Club" or "NCRG" refer to The Northern Corridor Radio Group Inc.

1. All members will conduct themselves with decorum with due regard to the club's image and prevailing circumstances.
2. Keys for club house and surrounding buildings are controlled by the TREASURER and are available to members after 1 year of financial membership.
3. All members and visitors are required to sign the attendance register at each meeting and to also sign into the visitor's book (located near the main entrance) at every visit outside normal meeting times.
4. All Club business is CONFIDENTIAL, all and any items discussed at any meeting or other gathering must not be discussed or otherwise divulged to anyone outside of the membership. The President is the sole authorized spokesman for all announcements and other communications. He may, however, nominate a member to make specific disclosures in connection club events or as part of a reporting function on news broadcasts.
5. The Club reserves the right to exclude non-members at its discretion. The attendance at meetings and Club functions by visitors is on the proviso that the person inviting such persons has informed them that this possibility exists. The PRESIDENT'S ruling on any attendance is final and binding to all persons without discussion.
6. No smoking permitted inside club premises. Members and visitors are expected to comply with requests regarding smoking and general conduct within the Club boundaries.
7. All visitors and members shall comply with site requirements of Whiteman Park owners and management or Perth Regional Appaloosa Club.
8. All radio usage shall be within the terms of the operators license. Members and/or their visitors identified breaching this legal requirement will be asked to justify their actions and may be excluded from the Club.
9. The Club is not responsible for any members property. This includes any item loaned to the Club or left at club premises without the Presidents knowledge and consent.
10. If any club member either brings the Club into disrepute through their public or private actions or causes any adverse publicity or comment to be generated or circulated which tarnishes the Club's image or creates bad public perception of the Club or it's members, that, at a duly convened meeting and by a majority of financial members vote that those person/s membership will be automatically terminated. Any Club property in their possession will be required to be returned within 48 hours of their notification by the Club President who will give to them the reason for membership termination in writing. Any claims for payment of any outstanding moneys payable by the Club for duly authorized club equipment or service shall be notified to the President at the time of notice service on the member. The Club will then determine payment of this amount (if any) at the next convened meeting and if approved, will post a cheque for said amount to the ex-member's last known address. Withholding any Club property against settlement of any outstanding matters will be considered a criminal offence and action may be taken accordingly.
11. Any member standing for office at the NCRG will have been a member of the NCRG for a period not less than (3) years.
